CREATIVITY PHONICS

OBJECTIVE


Students will do a creative activity about phonics, this will help them better understand the relationship between letters and the sounds they make.

MATERIALS

Colored construction paper and markers.

LESSON

I will show students an example before having them do it, but students will cut construction paper into five flower petals, they can be different colors if they want. Students will also cut the pistil (the middle part), the stem and the leaves of a flower. The pistil will have a letter or sound that the students chose, and the petals will have drawings that represent words beginning with the letter or sound in the middle. For example, if the letter in the middle was S, the petals would have drawings of socks, the sun, the number six and so forth.



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
