This lesson is for students who learn through visuals

Focus is on:

Vocabulary:

♦ Nouns, Verbs, and Adjectives

Materials:

Worksheet Flash cards with the vocabulary words on th Plain piece of paper Pencil



Goals:

- 1. Students will be able to understand the difference between nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- 2. Students will be able to put the vocabulary words into categories correctly.
- 3. Students will be able to write each vocabulary word correctly in a sentence based on the color of the flashcard.

Instructions:

- 1. Create flashcards with appropriate vocabulary words on them.
- 2. Describe that each color of the flashcards represents a different category (nouns, pronouns, verbs and adjectives).
 - a. Yellow-Nouns
 - b. Red-Verbs
 - c. Blue-Adjectives
- 3. Go over the definitions for nouns, verbs, and adjectives.
- 4. Tell the students that they will go through the flashcards and write a sentence using that word.
 - a. They should also write above the sentence if it is a noun, verb, or adjective.
